What is your Job Title? Can you explain what you do on a day to day basis? My job title is an Apprentice Building Control Officer. On a day to day basis the role can be varied, ranging from registering new applications, taking calls, replying to emails, working through the process of plan vetting, once a week I go out onsite shadowing one of my colleagues on their site inspections checking building work is being constructed correctly and to the Building Regulations.

How did you find the Apprenticeship Programme? I found the programme advertised on WM Jobs and applied from there. The process was really easy and efficient.

What is the best thing about the Apprenticeship? You get chance to put the disciplines and elements you learn at University into practice and you get the real life experience on site which makes it easier to understand and apply to the job.

How does the Apprenticeship work- How do you cover the off job training element?
