We know that by working together to support families, providing Early Help and eradicating silo working prevents children and young people from entering the care system, increases their chances to have a 'good' life, reduces the likelihood of involvement in crime and helps families into work.

We, the Early Help partnership in 2021 refreshed our focus and following a consultation where the importance of providing and creating opportunities to network was strongly advocated we developed, at a local level our 'Time 2 Talk: Partnership, Practice and Progress' forums.

These forums are a platform for local services to meet together, network and to:

- Build capacity to improve the delivery of preventative and targeted services to meet local needs
- Create opportunities for integrated partnership at a locality level
- Promote the ambition and opportunities we all have for families across the borough to thrive, ensuring we don't just 'avoid poor outcomes'
- Meet, talk, network
