Theme 1 - New Models of Care

- New models for equipment, assistive technology, community alarms and response services
- Ensuring value for money; commissioning reviews, de-commissioning and commissioning activity (including prevention services) in line with ASC savings
- Through plan, do, study, act (PDSA) develop new pathways, processes and procedures for new model of delivery e.g. Intermediate Care
- Engagement; embed service users, carers and families in all elements of the commissioning cycle and across ASC business
- Improve and maintain quality standards of accommodation

Theme 2 – Controlling Cost and Enabling Change

- Commitment at Resource Allocation Panel, Deep Dive reviews and Valuing Care
- Decommissioning activity e.g. ILC; Advocacy services
- Electronic Call Monitoring
- Flexible Contracting arrangements (ISF's)
- Model joint funding tool for top 20 high cost packages for non CHC clients
- Fee increase during a period of intense financial challenge

Theme 3 – Sustainable Communities & Social Care Market

- Mobilisation of Community Based Services framework;
 - Setting of guarantee
 - Complex needs supported living arrangements
- Implement new framework for Residential & Nursing on behalf of WMBC and WCCG
 - Changes to FNC arrangements (1 August)
- Review of respite and day care services for complex clients
- Remodel and tender DPSS
- Commission housing floating support services across localities for adults with complex
- Work with our local Healthwatch
