Table A3a identifies all the Other Existing Waste Sites currently shown as small yellow diamond symbols (◆) on the Draft SAD Policies Map, which would be subject to Draft Policy W2. The Strategic Waste Sites, which are listed in the draft policy, are shown as yellow triangle symbols (▲).

Tables A3b and A3bc summarise the outcome of the Council's review of existing waste sites carried out in 2015. They update the information in Tables 1 and 3 of Appendix 8a of the SAD Issues & Options Report (April 2013), which listed the proposed Strategic Waste Sites and Non-Strategic Waste Sites. The information in the tables has been updated using evidence from the Environment Agency Public Register, which lists all sites with Waste Permits and Scrap Metal Dealer Licences @ 31.03.15, and information on new planning applications and permissions for waste management development from the Walsall Council Planning Register. The "baseline" date for the information in the table is 31.03.15 although where more recent information has become available for specific sites (up to July 2015) it has been recorded in the tables. The key at the end of the Appendix explains the colour-coding of sites not identified in Draft SAD Policy W2 as Strategic Waste Sites or in Table A3a as Other Existing Waste Sites.
