Description of proposal

Title for consultation: Change of name deeds

A deed poll is a legal document that proves a change of name. Anyone in the UK over 18 is entitled to change their name if they wish, however many official bodies, such as bank and building societies, will require a change of name deed to accept the change. It is proposed that the council's registrars service will offer a change of name deed service. Many other local authorities already offer this service.

This new service which would be delivered within existing resources / budgets. Fees would be set in line with those charged by other local authorities. If approved the service would start once current vacancies in the Registrar's team have been filled.

New income: £3,000
