#### **Description of proposal**

Title for consultation: Walsall Arena online ticketing

Walsall Arena, based in Leamore, is the borough's multi-purpose performance venue. Every year it hosts a numerous range of events, from aerial theatre and comedy to dance and large-scale vocal concerts. The Arena is building a reputation with performers and audiences for its fantastic facilities. To improve the service and increase ticket sales, an online ticketing system is proposed. Digital tickets offer a more efficient and secure process. Customers would be able to purchase tickets online, over the phone and face to face.

New income: £75,000 phased over 4 years from 2024/25.

#### **Estimated Net Saving / new income**

£75,000.

#### Summary of evidence, engagement, and consultation

4 responses on this proposal were made via the online survey, 14% of all responses received.

Overall, 75% (3 people) fully supported the proposal with one respondent saying they supported it but with concerns or amendments.

Comments from those who supported the proposal included;

"It will be far easier to book tickets and I'd be more likely to do this with it being online."

"Sell paper tickets too for a few people like to have a [paper] ticket - make it an upsell extra."

One raised concern about access to digital ticketing:

"I feel going completely online with impact people who are unable to access the internet to purchase these."

In terms of alternative suggestions one person said;

"Keep booking great acts and shows, make it a great night out with the full experience people expect."

#### Overall opinion from engagement and consultation

Respondents generally support this proposal.
