Welcome and Introductions

1. Declarations of Interest

None were declared.

2. Minutes (Public) of the previous meeting and actions update.

Shared public minutes from the last meeting on 15 November 2023.

The minutes were accepted as an accurate record by Manjit Jhooty and Rupert Fairfax seconded this.

3. Bloxwich Advisory Board - Chair's update

Rupert Fairfax provided an update:

Since the last Town Deal Board, the Bloxwich Advisory met on the 25 January 2024, latest 1 hour and 35 minutes.

Project Updates

Marketing and Comms: To raise the profile of the projects, such as The Bloxwich Launchpad, the allotments, the media reporter visited the Bloxwich area and had a full page in the Express & Star, Comms work taking place with all the projects, for example, signage for a number of sites; Guildhall, Connected Gateway, King George V and Bloxwich Launchpad to go out tender in February 2024, lots of interest.

Green Bloxwich: The sports project was making satisfactory progress, planning applications were progressing well, all positive for The Lodge and Pavilion.

Incubation Centre: key project the Bloxwich Launchpad, Works to get back to go out to tender this month.

Active travel and connectivity program progressing well, the Canal improvements had completed their first phase on time including the renewal of 8 1/2 kilometres of toe paths and associated entrances and these will be topped off and the installation of solar lighting in the spring.

The highways improvements being completed to Elmore Green and Croxdene Roads, including two new pedestrian crossings and cycle ways. Plans for the widening of the A34 bridge near to Homeserve are being developed and will hopefully start during the summer. Work to progress the new bus shelters between Bloxwich & Walsall are being progressed.

The construction skills through regeneration program went out to open call recently to attract bids from registered social landlords in Bloxwich, with one application received and being assessed.

Community Capital Programme - 2 projects been approved and can move to the contracting stage with applicants also being assisted by the external funding team to secure additional resources. This aims to reduce the call on towns funding, freeing up funding for other applicants. All projects were progressing well and on target, with no concerns so far.

4. Walsall Advisory Board - Chair's update:

Since the last Town Deal Board, the Walsall Advisory Board met on the 16 January 2024, closed the actions from the previous meeting, time allowed as 1 ½ worked much better.

Comms: Credit to Natahsa Mann and Keith Beech lots of marketing and comms taking place. In terms of combination of media marketing and getting the messages out there in a multiple of different platforms from digital to local to press to more traditional methods.

Active Public Spaces Programme: RIBA 4 planning stage completed, regarding the expenditure, this is on budget.

Creative Industries Centre: Secured the Planning permission on 30th November 2023, project is now at the RIBA Stage 4.

Adult Learning Centre: In terms of the employment hub at 46 Park Street, this has been completed and named as 'The Link', opened to the public at the beginning of January 2024.

Construction Skills Academy: This is open and up and running, already had a visit from Andy Street with student numbers higher than expected, looking to secure someone from government to open the centre.

Digital Skills Programme: The contracts were completed in December 2023, the refurbishment work started on the 8th of January 2024 and is progressing.

Power BI: A brief update was given on Verto, the team are looking to provide project updates as dashboard reports, allowing all to see what was taking place with the projects.

Finances are being shared, nothing of concern at this time.

5. Marketing & Communications - Update

NM/Colleagues to update Board members briefly on progress and coverage.

Working on delivering print material, linked with schools to promote the Regeneration program message to highlight in schools and colleges.

The Connected Gateway engagement project has moved forward, therefore working to have marketing coverage before the pre-election period and started to deliver print materials.

Arranged for in person briefing event for Town centre businesses which is taking place at the end of the month and organised an ambassador briefing on 15 March 2024, some of the Board members will be attending as part of our ambassador program.

Recently linked with the Combined Authority they are an independent careers advisor for schools, and deal with all of Walsall schools.
