REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is hereby given that Walsall Council (The Licensing Authority) has received notice pursuant to Section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 from West Midlands Police for a Premises Licence Summary Review relating to:

Discotheque (aka DeCode) – 133 Lichfield Street, Walsall, WS1 1SL.

The grounds of the application for review are that:

In the opinion of a senior police officer of West Midlands Police these premises are associated with serious crime or disorder or both.
