Welcome to the Walsall Works Jobs and Skills EXPO which is in its 10th year! For the first time this year we are also delighted to invite you to the first Apprenticeship Show. In the past 10 years we have regularly attracted a 1000 job seekers and 75+ exhibitors at each event. The Walsall Works EXPO is now a recognised brand for customers and businesses alike. It's an exciting time for job seekers, employers, and those looking to improve their skills as there are new fully funded training programmes on offer.

In recent years, the UK labour market has faced significant challenges, but with these challenges also comes opportunity. In 2024, Walsall Works supported 1797 residents and worked directly with 97 businesses, enabling 596 people gaining employment and 579 into education and training. Unemployment rates have seen fluctuations, and there remains a pressing need to address certain areas, especially youth unemployment. Young people, in particular, continue to face a tougher job market, with many struggling to find sustainable employment. In Walsall 22.8% are economically inactive and many young people have left school with no qualifications, so the focus is on bridging the gap between education and employment, ensuring that young people are equipped with the skills and confidence they need to enter the workforce.

The Government has introduced a range of initiatives to tackle these issues through the White Paper 'Get Britain Working'. Key schemes such as increasing pre-apprenticeships, new work placements, supporting those with health issues back into work and localised training programmes are designed to empower individuals with the skills and attitude that employers are looking for. Furthermore, there are targeted efforts to improve employment opportunities in sectors like Digital, Green Energy, and Healthcare, where demand for skilled workers is growing rapidly.

This event represents a fantastic opportunity to explore the wide range of resources, support networks, and career opportunities available in our borough. Whether you are a young person, a job seeker, an employer, a training provider or an individual looking to learn new skills or make valuable connections, today is the day to engage with exhibitors that meet your needs.

We hope this EXPO and Apprenticeship Show inspires and equips you to take the next step in your career journey, whatever that may be. Enjoy the day and make the most of the
