


What is the Summer Learning Passport?

The Summer Learning Passport is a special booklet filled with a variety of activities and challenges for your child to complete over the summer. These activities are designed to be both enjoyable and educational, covering a range of subjects including developing independence, playing and socialising, eating and drinking, speaking, listening and understanding, reading, writing, and fostering a love for learning.

How Does It Work?

- Receive the Passport: You can register and collect your child's Summer Learning Passport from your local family hub or library from 11th July 2025
- Complete Activities: Throughout the summer, your child can choose from a wide range of activities listed in the passport. Each activity is not only fun but also focuses on a key area of development for your child. Upon completion, each activity earns them a stamp.
- Track Progress: As your child completes activities, they can track their progress in the passport. This keeps them motivated and provides a sense of accomplishment.
- Celebrate Achievements: When you register for your child's passport, you will automatically be entered into a prize draw. Additionally, you and your child will receive a certificate.

Why Participate?

- **Keep Learning Fun:** The activities are designed to be enjoyable and engaging, making learning a fun part of your child's summer.
- Prepare for School: By participating in educational activities, your child can learn new skills, gain new experiences, and be introduced to key concepts they can further develop when they start school.
- Support for You: The activities and information shared with you will help you understand how to support your child in becoming school-ready and inform you about the services available to assist you throughout this journey.



Making your own binoculars to see what you can see high in the sky or low on the ground.

You will need:

2 x empty toilet/kitchen towel rolls

Long lengths of wool or string

Paint and other decorations



Step 2:

Tie a long enough string to one side of the binoculars, by making a little hole using a pen etc

to each side, then knot on the inside



Step 1:

Wrap the wool string around the 2 cardboard rolls

Paint/colour or stick to decorate to your fancy

Decorate how you wish



Step 3:

Go outside and start bird watching!



Make Your Own Telescope

You will need:

2x kitchen roll tubes

Paint

Scissors

Step 1:

Cut one of the tubes all the way down length ways so that you can curl it to fit inside the other tube.

Step 2:


Paint both tubes which ever colour you like, even make a pattern on it, leave to dry.

Now curl the cut tube and place inside the other tube, you can now make your telescope long or short, have a look around with it, what can you see?

Elephant mask

You will need

2 x paper plates

Cardboard tube or, draw a trunk shape on paper and cut out

Scissors

Grey paint, if you don't add grey you can mix white and black or white paint with a little black food colouring

Glue

Lollipop stick

Step 1:

Cut 2 holes in one of your plates for you to see through

Step 2:

Take the cardboard tube, this will be the trunk, cut flaps around the bottom and push them up so that you can attach to the paper plate, glue them together.

Jave you seen Elephant?

Step 3:

Next, take the second paper plate, cut it in half and round off the edges, this will be the ears, attach with glue to each side of the plate.

You are now ready to paint your elephant grey.

Once dry you can add a lollipop stick to the bottom of the plate to hold up your mask.
