- 1. **Notice is hereby given** that Walsall Council is conducting a review of the polling districts and polling places within Walsall borough in accordance with the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013.

- 3. Alternatively, paper copies can be inspected at Walsall Council Libraries and at the Electoral Services Office.
- 4. Feedback is welcomed from all Walsall residents and other interested persons and bodies, including elected representatives and those with expertise in access to premises or facilities for disabled people. The (Acting) Returning Officer for the parts of the parliamentary Wolverhampton constituencies that fall within the Walsall borough may make representations.
- 5. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
